## ORDER OF DISMISSAL

## Before: Judge Merlin

On July 25, 1991, the complainant, Bruce A. Williams, filed with this Commission a complaint of discrimination under section 105(c) of the Federal Mine Safety and Health Act of 1977. On July 25, 1991, a letter was sent to Mr. Williams directing him to provide information regarding his complaint. On January 17, 1992, my law clerk attempted to contact Mr. Williams by telephone to ascertain whether the information had been sent, but the phone had been disconnected. On January 24, 1992, an order was issued directing Mr. Williams to submit the information or show cause why the complaint should not be dismissed.
