This case is before me on remand from the Commission. *Spartan Mining Co.*, 27 FMSHRC \_\_\_\_, slip op. at 2, No. WEVA 2002-111-R (Nov. 16, 2005). Noting that Cannelton Industries, Inc., the previous owner of the mine, paid the civil penalty assessed for this violation prior to selling the mine, Spartan Mining has requested leave to withdraw the Notice of Contest.
